Ensures a safe and productive environment for collegians and staff.

- Manages chapter/campus crisis as it relates to chapter residents.
- Observes Alpha Gamma Delta/Beta Omicron policies and procedures.
- Enforces house rules.
- Works closely with the collegian property advisor to maintain a safe and clean-living environment.
- Informs Property Advisor or Chapter Advisor of maintenance needs.
- Works with the kitchen and housekeeping staff while coordinating input from the collegians and Property Advisor.
- Works with Property Coordinator to ensure house duties are completed and house supplies are plentiful.
- Communicates house maintenance issues to the Property Advisor.
- Assists Property Coordinator in managing monthly meal menu/weekend food ensuring that meals are well balanced and ensuring that home supplies are in stock
- Communicates any unusual trends and/or problems within the chapter to the Property Advisor or Chapter Advisor.
- Adheres to campus, sorority and chapter policies and rules.
- Communicates regularly with chapter President and Property Advisor.
- Models and encourages proper communication and respect among members.
- Assists in ensuring safe departure of chapter members before a chapter function
- Provides supportive counseling to members as needed.
- Creates a comfortable atmosphere within the chapter house.

- Ability to work independently

- Ability to perform basic functions of Internet, Google Docs, Microsoft Outlook, Word and Excel such as simple spreadsheets and scanning of PDF files
